connection of urban trails with camino real, rio grande trail, Insights dinosaur tracks trail :-), etc.

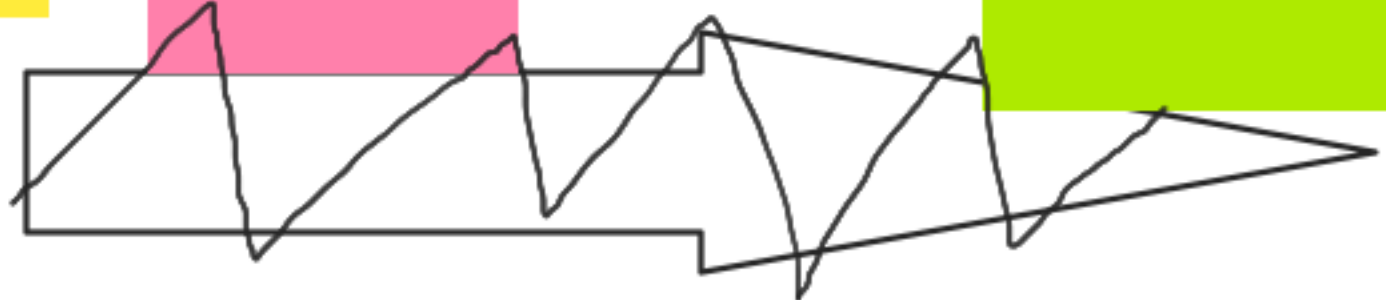
Texas has "walk across Texas" it would be neat to have "walk the El Camino Real
